

# Music Development Program



## Terms and Conditions

1. The Music Development Program ("Program") accepts students based on an application, supporting documentation, and an interview at the discretion of the Principal or delegate.
2. Applicants must be enrolled at Our Lady of Mercy College Parramatta ("OLMC").
3. To be eligible, applicants must be in Year 7, 8 or 9 for the year in which they are chosen to participate in the Program.
4. The Program will cover the cost of weekly tuition lessons for the school year. All other costs including, but not limited to, the hire of the instrument are required to be met in full by the parent/carer.
5. The Program is awarded for one year and is subject to a review at the end of each school term. It is expected that the recipient will complete Year 12 at OLMC. Should this not occur, then it is at the discretion of the Principal or delegate to require that the value equivalent to part or all of the program fees be payable to the College.
6. Students awarded the Music Development Program are required to contribute fully to the life of the College, including maintaining standards as outlined in the program. The College reserves the right to review a student's performance at any time and in the unlikely event the Principal or delegate decides to discontinue a student in the program, you will be provided with four (4) weeks' notice of intention to withdraw a student. You will be given the opportunity to respond and give reasons why the proposed withdrawal is considered, by you, to be inappropriate.
7. Successful recipients are expected to commit to developing and performing each year of the program, including regular attendance at weekly lessons during the school term; practice of the chosen instrument in personal time; participation in College Concert Band or College Orchestra rehearsals and performances (based on performance level); performing at approximately four (4) public events per year; and engaging in before and after school hours commitments.
8. OLMC may need, from time to time, to include your daughter's name and photograph, in our print and/or digital advertising and marketing, this may include written reports and communications.
