



Danebank Return to On-Campus Learning Plan

Danebank Health Action Plan

Danebank's Health Action Plan is updated according to the latest advice from the federal government:

- Arrivals from any country are to self-isolate for 14 days from the day of their arrival in Australia. This applies to staff, students and members of our community.
- Everyone who has been in contact with someone who has arrived from any overseas country, is to exercise a high degree of caution. They are to self-monitor for symptoms and not come to school if feeling unwell. If needed, seek medical advice urgently and isolate yourself.
- Students and staff who are unwell with any respiratory illness or flu-like symptoms should remain at home until all symptoms have disappeared.
- Any student or staff member who has been in close personal contact with someone diagnosed with coronavirus must remain at home for 14 days following that contact.
- Any confirmed case of COVID-19 will be excluded from attending school until medically cleared to return.

PHASE 0

Schools are open for families who need it

- Families are supported to keep their children at home and learn from home via Danebank's distance learning model.
- Students who attend school are supervised by qualified teachers, not in their classrooms by their classroom teacher.
- No excursions, activities or inter-school activities.

PHASE 1

Girls on campus at least one day a week

- **Year 12:** full-time face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Pre-K and Kinder:** full-time face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Life Skills:** full-time face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Years 1 to Year 11:** one day a week face-to-face teaching on campus with their classroom teachers and four days a week distance learning at home.
- Families who need to send their children to school every day when not engaged in face-to-face teaching, may do so. Children will be supervised as they undertake distance learning. Register here for [Junior School](#) Register here for [Senior School](#)
- No excursions, activities or inter-school activities

PHASE 2

Girls on campus at least two days a week

- **Years 11 and 12:** full-time face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Pre-K and Kinder:** full-time for face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Life Skills:** full-time face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Years 1 to Year 10:** two days a week face-to-face teaching on campus with their classroom teachers and three days a week distance learning at home.
- Families who need to send their children to school every day when not engaged in face-to-face teaching, may do so. Children will be supervised as they undertake distance learning. Registration links available in due course.
- No excursions, activities or inter-school activities.

Girls on campus between three to five days a week

- **Years 11 and 12:** full-time face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Pre-K and Kinder:** full-time for face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Life Skills:** full-time face-to-face teaching on campus.
- **Years 1 to Year 10:** three to five days a week face-to-face teaching on campus with their classroom teachers, the rest of the time, distance learning at home.
- Families who need to send their children to school every day when not engaged in face-to-face teaching, may do so. Children will be supervised as they undertake distance learning. Registration links available in due course.
- No excursions, activities or inter-school activities.

PHASE 4

Girls on campus five days a week, with full activities

- Normal school for all girls (Pre-K to Year 12) full-time, five days a week.
- Participation in school excursions and inter-school activities.
