Dear Parents and Carers,

We look forward to seeing all our students back at school next week for at least one day. There are different plans for different year groups in the school, and you have been informed of the return to school plan for your child/ren's class(es). I can assure you that Monday will be a happy day!

We will review the return progress next week and keep you posted on any changes to the plan for the following week.

We have strict cleaning controls in place for every classroom. In addition:

- Any student or staff member who shows any symptoms of illness must stay at home
- Any student who has a family member with a compromised immune system may stay at home if he/she wishes and complete school work at home
- Isolation procedures including temperature checks will be in place for any student who develops symptoms of illness during the day
- Parents are not to enter any campus of the school unless there is an urgent need.

On Monday and Tuesday next week, all regular supervision duties for drop off and pick up of students, including the traffic controller on Eastern Valley Way, will be operating. The Middle Cove Traffic Management plan will be back in place for Monday/Tuesday:

- Only parents of Classes 3 and 4 are to enter Glenroy Avenue for drop off/pick up
- Do not stop, park, drop off or pick up in Greenfield Avenue
- All students from Class 5 to Year 12 are to use buses or be met by parents in adjoining streets (Tyneside Avenue or North Arm Road).

We request all parents meeting younger students at both campuses to maintain appropriate social distancing.

This COVID-19 time has had many challenges and there are more still to confront, but at least we are on the way back to normal school attendance.

Thank you for your cooperation, patience and understanding of the complexities we have had to face, and I trust we emerge from this time as better people, and a stronger community.
