Just last Tuesday two schools in the eastern suburbs registered a confirmed case each, and they were closed for the rest of the week. There is a clear protocol to follow and we have well prepared plans. As was the case with those schools, we would immediately contact all parents to inform you that students need to return home. We have arrangements in place ready to facilitate the return home of students including their pickup from any of our campuses.
