Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to outline how these requirements throughout Sydney will affect Glennaeon for the next two weeks. Our three campuses will be closed although there will be some essential services operating as per the exemptions in the Public Health Order:

- Maintenance services
- One Year 12 class in a practical subject
- Holiday Care at Castlecrag
- Preschool Vacation program

These services will all be subject to strict COVID controls: please follow the identified parent drop off and pick up positions, regular cleaning a number of times per day, staff and students not to attend if unwell, plus all personal hygiene protocols in place.

All other services, including all other Year 12 HSC revision and preparation lessons, will be conducted remotely.
