2021 Primary Beginner Instrumental Program Recruitment

Dear Parents,

Students at RJAS are invited to participate in the Primary Beginner Instrumental Program. The groups on offer in 2021 are;

Groovy Guitars - a Primary Beginner Guitar Program: consisting of a weekly 30-minute tutorial; and a 45-minute Ensemble rehearsal.

Beginner (Novello) Strings - consisting of a weekly 30-minute tutorial; and a 45-minute Ensemble rehearsal.

Beginner Concert Band - consisting of a weekly 30-minute tutorial; and a 45-minute Ensemble rehearsal.

Independent studies have indicated that between the approximate ages of 8 - 10 years of age a child has the fine motor co-ordination and maturity to cope with the rigors of learning and committing to a musical instrument.

Therefore, to be eligible to apply, a student should be in:

- this year's **Year 3** (or above) for **Groovy Guitar Ensemble**
- this year's **Year 3** (or above) for **Novello Strings**
- this year's **Year 4** (or above) for **Beginner Concert Band**.

Students will undertake a number of brief melodic and rhythmic activities to assess their musical readiness for an ensemble tutorial in a group situation. The students will then be assessed on their suitability for a particular instrument. It is most important to understand that there are fees associated with the Beginner Instrumental Program. Membership fees are \$50 per term. This includes a weekly 45-minute Beginner Band/Strings/Guitar rehearsal, plus a weekly 30-minute group tutorial. Students who are accepted into the Beginner Instrumental Program but do not own their own instrument may hire a School Instrument at an additional rate of \$50 per term. Instrumental Program fees are added to each term's School Fees. If your child discontinues the Beginner Instrumental program during the year, notification **in writing to the Music Co-ordinator** is required and **no adjustment** will be made to fees payable for that term.
