Developed by TBA, Fast Track is a fully structured training program designed specifically to provide a pathway for new people to enter the breeding industry workforce.

Successful applicants commence a 12-month traineeship with a reputable stud farm while studying for a Certificate III in Horse Breeding - a nationally recognised formal qualification.

To complement their on-the-job learning, students take part in two intensive learning blocks (six weeks in total) in the Hunter Valley where they receive high-class training from a number of industry professionals and also take part in a variety of field trips, as well as personal development workshops.
