Guaranteed Entry Requirements at the University of Sydney

[Guaranteed Entry](#) gives students a confirmed place in an eligible degree if they achieve the required selection rank and meet any other admissions criteria.

A selection rank is your student's ATAR or equivalent score plus any adjustment factors they receive through admission schemes and pathways.

If students don't meet the guaranteed selection rank, they may still be eligible to receive an offer depending on the availability of places in the course.

Some courses do not offer guaranteed entry and will publish an indicative selection rank as a guide.

Students entering teaching programs (except early childhood and including [B Music \(Music Education\)](#)) will need a minimum of three Band 5s in their HSC, one of which must be English (not ESL).

Similar requirements apply to the IB and [other Australian Year 12 qualifications](#).

For all other secondary qualifications, applicants need to achieve the minimum admission score and good results in English (not ESL).
