Bond University: Year 12 early offers for 2023: How it works

Bond University's Year 12 Early Guaranteed Offer Scheme recognises the challenges students have faced over the past few years of senior schooling. Eligible students can receive an offer to study at Bond in 2023 before final ATAR or IB Diploma results are released, providing certainty about your future study options.

Year 12 early offers for 2023: How it works

Complete Bond's direct online application, submitting results from your Semester 1 (Term 1 and Term 2) Year 12 report, as well as your full Year 11 report card. Bond University will assess your application and high school grades against the minimum entry requirements for Bond's undergraduate* and diploma programs.

If you meet the entry requirements, you receive an early offer for 2023 January, May or September intake - that guarantees entry into your Bond program, conditional on the completion of Year 12 and meeting any subject prerequisite requirements for your program. When you successfully complete Year 12 and pass any prerequisite subjects, your offer becomes unconditional and you are officially a Bondy!

Updated: SAT and ACT test dates in a test-optional landscape

The application process to US universities can be complex and requires applicants to start the process early, ideally in year 10. This is because US universities assess an applicant from year nine and undertake a holistic admission process reviewing many components in the application process, including submitting either an SAT or ACT test score. US universities do not have a preference as to whether a student sits the SAT or the ACT. Both are private external tests measuring maths, English, and reading. The ACT has a separately scored science section.

Physical Aptitude Test - FireFit Training Guide from NSW Fire and Rescue

As firefighters, we put life first and we train to get it right.

Firefighting is a physically demanding occupation. Tasks include carrying heavy loads including personal protective equipment, handling temperature extremes, variable terrains and confined spaces, all of which impose unique physical and physiological demands upon firefighters.

The FireFit Training Guide is based on an eight to 12-week program, depending on each individual's fitness level, and is available to help eligible candidates prepare for the Fire and Rescue NSW Physical Aptitude Test (PAT)*.

We have created a series of exercise focused videos called "Train Like a Firefighter" that will show you how each exercise relates to the physical demands required of firefighters.
