Students can be considered for EAPL points for undergraduate study at UNSW. The EAPL Program awards up to five points to high school leavers who have excelled in areas of sport, academia,



leadership, and/or music at an elite level. Activities and/or commitments must have been undertaken in years 11 and/or 12.
